BACKSTEDT AND HARMON - THE RRA 25 MILE RECORD

Winner of the grueling Paris-Roubaix race, Magnus Backstedt and Eurosport cycling commentator David Harmon have teamed up in 2011 in an all out attempt to break the open 25 record on board Rocket 2.

World Champions, World Record holders, professionals and amateurs from all over the world have attacked the great road records of the UK. In 2011 Project 7 Racing will be using all the latest technology in their attempt to set fastest times for at least two of these historic records.

Undoubtedly the 'blue ribband' of short distance records in the open

25 mile and P7R will field a serious attack with former Paris-Roubaix, Tour de France and Giro d'Italia stage winner winner **Magnus Backstedt** and Eurosport cycling commentator **David Harmon**.

The first press reports of tandem bicycle record breaking appeared in 'Bicycling News' in 1888, the year Albone and Tingey established the record for 50 miles.

122 years later Project 7 Racing's media reach is perhaps a little greater.
